- Session Goals & Objectives —provide a detailed summary of your session listing both your goals/objectives - content should be brief. The narrative should describe the topics to be covered and explain context and significance of your presentation, including any measurable outcomes/results (please submit form on next page).
- Session Length—Sessions are one hour. If more time is needed for your talk, a Part I & Part II could be offered -- each would be one hour in length.
- Speaker Bio— a short 1-2 paragraph bio should also be included. Please include your current job title, organization, mailing and contact information as well as academic history (degree, discipline, academic institution) for each speaker.
